

How to Reach the Children's Diabetes Team

Your diabetes team is here to support you. A diabetes educator (nurse or dietitian) is available by phone or email weekdays from 7:30am to 4pm for non-urgent concerns. We do our best to respond within 24 hours. We can help with things like:

- Review of glucose records for insulin dose adjustment
- Help managing physical activity and diabetes
- General diabetes questions
- Requests for diabetes bloodwork results
- Requests for travel letters and information about travelling with diabetes (notify us at least two weeks in advance of travel)

When contacting us for insulin dose or pump setting adjustment please be ready with:

- Blood glucose records or glucose sensor reports
- Insulin types and doses
- Insulin pump information (upload pump at home)
- Relevant activity information
- Your thoughts about what needs to be adjusted

When contacting us by email be remember to include things like your child's full name, what brand of sensor and pump you are on, etc.

Urgent Concerns - Pager

A Diabetes Educator or Doctor can be reached by pager at any time for <u>urgent</u> concerns. On evenings and weekends we are not at the IWK and do not have access to medical charts. Examples of when to call the pager:

- During times of illness, vomiting or ketones and you are unsure what to do
- Persistent low blood sugar or have had a severe hypoglycemic (low) event
- Mistake made with insulin dose
- Insulin pump failure (please have pump settings ready)

New Diagnosis - Pager

Families are asked to call though the pager between **3pm and 4pm** for daily insulin adjustment when then are first diagnosed. This lasts about two weeks. Then families are asked to call the main phone line or email for routine adjustment.

Social Worker and Dietitians

The diabetes social worker can provide counselling and support to youth and/or their family for issues related to living with diabetes such as; adjusting to a new diagnosis, coping, burnout, and parent-teen conflict. The social worker can also provide guidance and referrals for mental health concerns, and financial resources such as drug coverage and the disability tax credit.

Your diabetes dietitians can help with things like carbohydrate counting, adjusting insulin to carb ratios or carb targets, and other nutrition questions or concerns. Your diabetes dietitians are also certified diabetes educators and also help with general diabetes education, insulin dose adjustment and on call coverage.

Appointments & Requests for Letters

Our booking and registration clerk is available weekdays 7:30am to 3:30pm to help with things like:

- Confirming, changing or cancelling appointments.
- Requesting letters from the physician or forms that need to be filled out by a physician.

An appointment letter will be mailed or emailed to you before your appointment. It is **very important that you read the full letter**. This letter will tell you about our cancellation/ no show policy and what to bring to your appointments. If you need to cancel, please let the booking clerk know as soon as possible so the spot can be filled.
